Nuisance plants are plants which are considered a nuisance because of their tendency to dominate plant communities and/or are considered harmful to humans. These plants may be native, naturalized or exotic. Plants on this list can be removed without environmental or greenway review. Other local, state, or federal laws may regulate removal of certain plants on this list.

Additional plant species are prohibited by adopted land use plans in specific areas or situations.
